Ripley Parish Council objects to Planning Application 16/P/00209. The proposal represents overdevelopment of a property within an established row of matching bungalows and is unacceptable under Ripley Parish Council Planning Policy, which discourages the extension of small dwellings to large (in line with GBC Policy H9). A small dwelling is defined as one which does not exceed 85 square metres gross internal floor space and will typically have no more than 2 bedrooms. Ripley Parish Council discourages overdevelopment of medium sized properties. The parish council recognises that extensions are sometimes needed to enable families to remain in Ripley, but discourages extensions which are disproportionate in size i.e. greater than 50% increase, resulting in buildings which are out of keeping with the area or out of proportion with the size of the plot. Ripley Parish Council also discourages conversion of bungalows to 2 or more storey dwellings.
