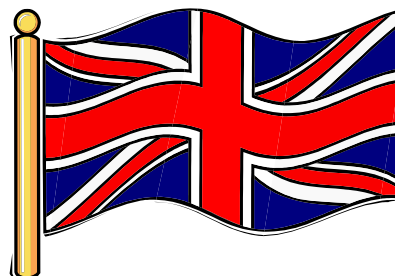

Burial Ground Extension

There are very few spaces left in the parish council burial ground adjacent to the closed churchyard at the Parish Church. Therefore the parish council is pleased to announce the successful purchase of a strip of land behind the High Street, between the church yard and the track by West End Cottages. It is hoped that part of this land will be used to provide an extension to the burial ground and the remainder will be kept as a wildlife area. A planning application for change of use will need to be submitted and if successful some clearance and landscaping will need to take place. The proposed burial ground will need to be consecrated by the Bishop before any burials can take place.
