WILDFLOWER MEADOW



The work to clear the brambles and dead elms along the boundary with Dunsborough Park has now been completed. The wildflower meadow has been sown between the 2 stands of sycamore trees and the remainder of the bare earth has been sown with grass seed.

BURIAL GROUND EXTENSION

At the end of February, 3 test holes were dug to approximately 3 metres in the proposed cemetery extension.

The results showed some water entering two of the holes at a depth of about 18 inches although the bottom was dry. The pictures were passed on to the Environment Agency.

The Environment Agency has not ruled out the possibility of using part of the land for burials and the parish council is now required to carry out a full Tier 1 groundwater risk assessment. 3 quotes have been obtained for this assessment.

Further costs will be incurred should the parish council get the go ahead to go forward to an application for change of use to a burial ground.
