P&E 034/23 PLANNING & ENVIRONMENT INFRASTRUCTURE SUB-COMMITTEE

Members received and considered matters ongoing under the remit of the P&E Committee:

i) National Highways – M25 J10/A3 Wisley Interchange Improvement Scheme update; Development Consent Order Regulation 19. Project Manager Jonathan Wade had provided a written update: *Further to progress with the DCO Requirement 19 works, see below a few notes by way of an update. We received comments from Surrey County Council (SCC) and yourselves, but not from Guildford Borough Council. Under the DCO, if a party declines to comment in within 28 days they are deemed to have accepted the proposals so I'm not concerned about that lack of engagement.*

Atkins have combined comments and amended the drawings to reflect them. We will proceed with the necessary surveying and design work in accordance with these comments. This will still take around 8 weeks as indicated on the programme. We are marginally behind the programme but not much. It's not a concern as we had a little time in hand plus the opening of the new Wisley Lane Diversion has also dropped back to end January / February 2024.

The volume of work across the project has increased significantly during the last couple of months and progress has generally been very good. The reduction of lanes approaching junction 10 from the A3 both north and southbound has caused lengthy delays in each direction and we have been chipping away by making minor changes to the A3 and junction layout.

The beams for Stratford Brook Bridge (on the Wisley Lane Diversion) are due to be lifted into place on 7th August. A similar operation to lift into place bridge beams for the Wisley Lane Diversion over the A3 will take place over the weekend of 30th September & 1st October. This is liable to result in the complete closure of the A3 south of junction 10 for the weekend.

We have been made aware of an issue with the SGN gas main leaking in the vicinity of the Ockham Park Roundabout. Not associated with this scheme, SGN are liable to be carrying out works here sometime later during the summer. We currently have no more details than that.

Cllr Ayears noted the council's historical liaison with National Highways and Surrey County Council over the DCO Regulation 19 and associated works across the parish. Ripley had ensured it had been involved at every available stage of the process. Mapping provided did not currently depict a speed table at the 30/20 change of speed limit proposed for Newark Lane. The scheme would need to be finalised by February 2024, with works to likely take place in 2025.

It was RESOLVED: That the correspondence be noted.

ii) National Highways compound at Nutberry Farm.

It was RESOLVED: That the item be considered at a future meeting.

Dear Sir / Madam

I'm writing having used your service earlier today. I am a regular user of the 463 from Clandon to Ripley and have nothing but praise for your service usually, so please don't think that I'm the sort of person who makes a big deal out of things.

Having planned by return journey home to travel via Clandon, knowing that the 463 service goes to Ripley, I was told on getting on the last bus available for that route that because the service was running late, it was going to cut the section out to Ripley altogether.

Now, I know it's only a 15 minute walk from Send Marsh to Ripley, but when a service is deprived to a village that doesn't have a lot of links anyway, particularly to Woking, it's an inconvenience. Bad enough for me traipsing a suitcase a mile down the road in the rain, but for people waiting in Ripley for a bus that wasn't going to arrive, even worse. The attitude of the driver was also not the best.

I'd be interested to hear if this is the policy that the Ripley section is going to be expendable when the bus is late running, and what that means for the passengers who rely on this service in the village. This is the second time this has happened with the same driver.

I've copied in Ripley Parish council into this as I am sure that they will be interested in knowing this so that the village residents can know they may need to make other arrangements instead of using the service.

Dear Terrance,

Thank you for your email and I'm sorry to hear about your experience with the 463 service. Drivers do not curtail services without instructions from the supervisor on bus control. We will take it up your complaint with the driver on this journey who should have informed you of any route alterations on the journey.

The 462/3 route is affected by increasing amount of traffic congestion on the A3 and due to extra traffic around RHS Gardens at Wisley and the new development at Wisley airfield. The timetable which we use is set by Surrey County Council and any feedback should also be directed to them.

We are always looking at ways to improve punctuality by adjusting our duties so services can start the 462/3 routes on time, but this can be very difficult within the current 2 bus operation. As it currently stands, adding an extra vehicle dedicated to the route is very expensive but we welcome any feedback from our customers.

Surrey County Council
Portsmouth Road (B2215) Ripley
Temporary Speed Limit Order 2023**

Surrey County Council propose to make the above mentioned Temporary Traffic Order under Section 14(1) and 14(7) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be; a) to prohibit vehicles from driving or proceeding at a speed greater than 30 MPH in that length of Portsmouth Road (B2215) Ripley as extends from its junction with (X7028) Heath Mews to its junction with the (B2215) High Street and; b) Suspend "The County Council of Surrey (B2215 High Street/ Portsmouth Road Ripley) (Speed Restriction) Order 1994 and/or any Speed Limit Order made or having effect as if made under Sections 82, 83 and/or 84 of the Act insofar as affects that length of Portsmouth Road (B2215) Ripley. This Temporary Traffic Order is required to allow new trunk main renewal works and/or any other associated works to be carried out by, or on behalf of J Browne Construction. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 16 weeks, between the hours of 7.30am and 5.30pm, within the 18 month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 05 August 2023. Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary speed limit which is anticipated to be in force 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. The speed limit imposed by this Order shall not apply to vehicles used by special forces in accordance with the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 or in respect of anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed on the road by or on behalf of the Police.

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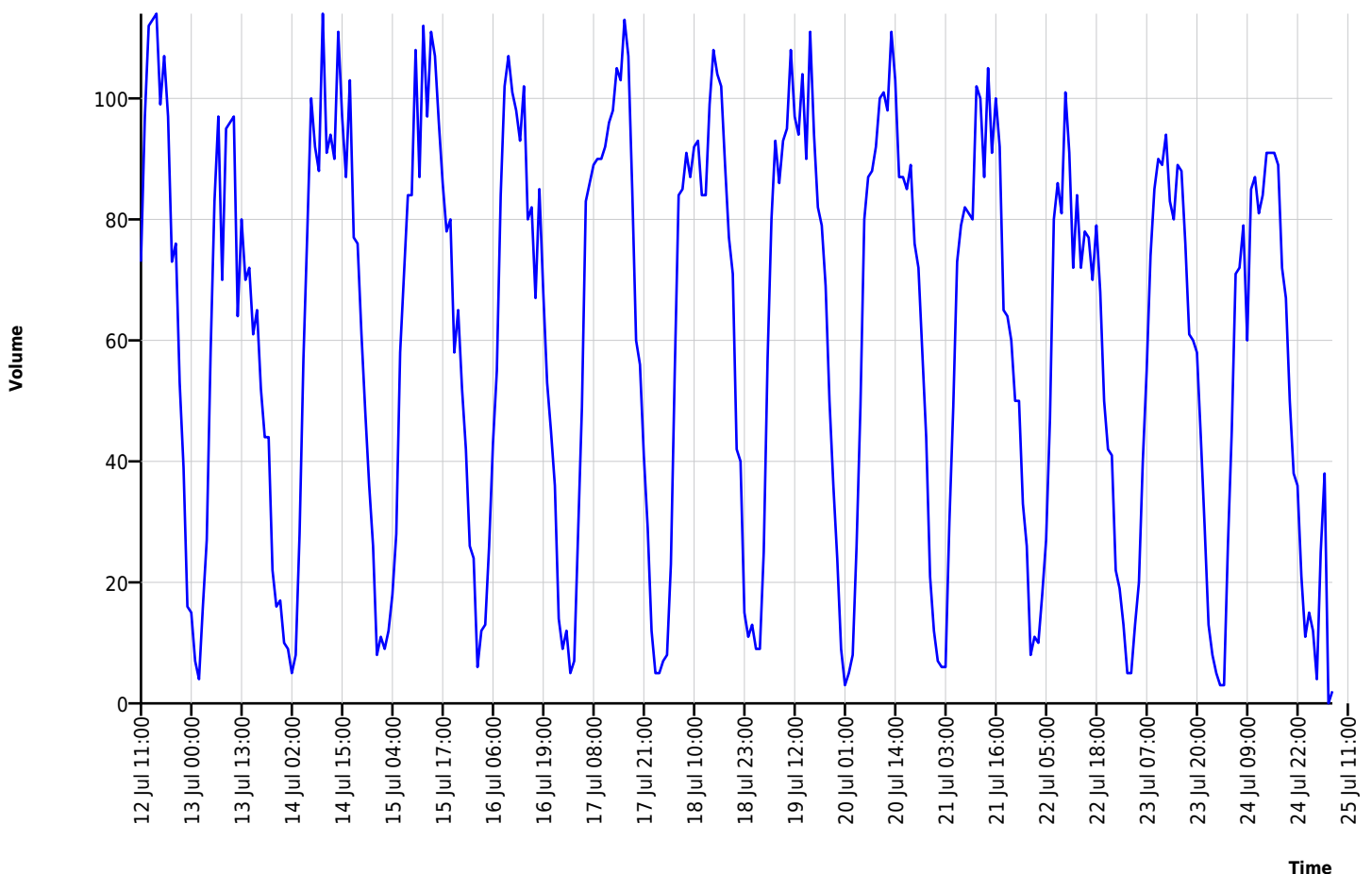

Time / Volume graph



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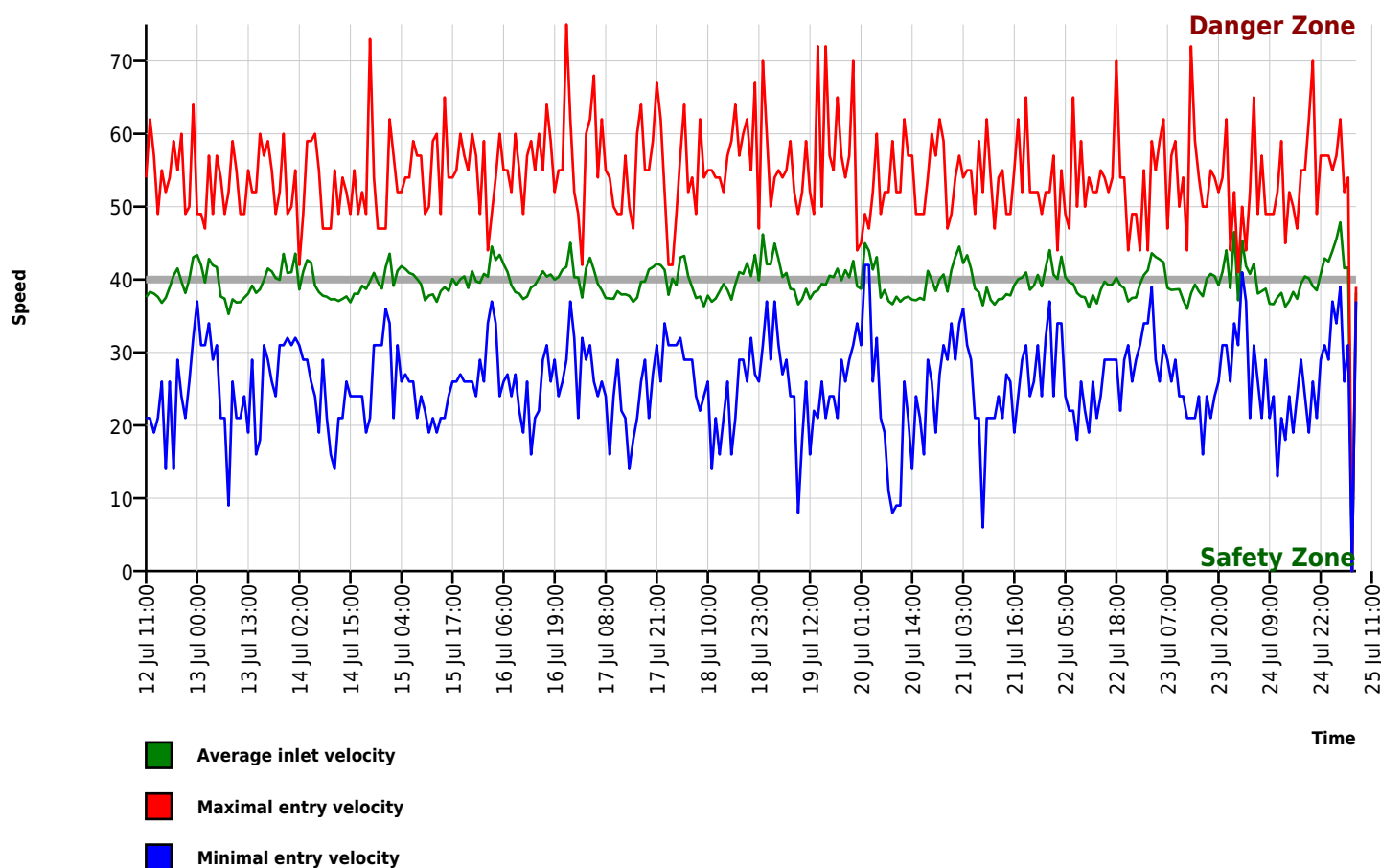
